

## **GUIDANCE FOR OVERSEAS CREWS**

Reading Town Regatta is a friendly and intimate regatta. We welcome overseas crews to compete on the Thames before Henley Royal Regatta or after Henley Womens Regatta.

Rowing is three abreast from stake boats and umpired from launches.  
Our prizes are traditional pewter pint tankards for senior events.

Many crews who come from overseas return every year they are in the UK and we can always put you in contact if you want to hear what the regatta is like.

It is possible to row from Henley through three locks and the beautiful countryside or alternatively we are usually able to arrange a trailer from Henley after the qualifying race. Boats can be left on our racks at the regatta site but this is entirely at your risk. It is possible to get a bus from Henley to 300yds from the regatta site or alternatively it is a 20 minute walk from Reading train station.

We have food and drink facilities (including warm English beer).
